May Meeting Minutes—Ron Varley

Meeting was called to order by President Sean Dowell at 7:30pm.

Members and guests in attendance. George Owen, Dave Massey, Dennis Dowell, Sean Dowell, Keith Bester, Lou Salini, Phil Ellerbrock, Jim Reiter, Chris Kresser and Ron Varley.

The meeting time was spent discussing whether GHA needs to remain incorporated as a nonprofit organization. GHA was approved by the IRS in 1998 as a nonprofit social organization and incorporated that same year as a Missouri nonprofit corporation. This action was taken because we were hosting Conclave 99 in St. Louis and wanted to have the limited liability protection of a corporation. GHA remained a Missouri nonprofit corporation after Conclave 99 because we continued to do events such as the Tri-Healey Meet every year for a number of years. We no longer do car events nor do we anticipate doing any in the foreseeable future.

This discussion was triggered by recent news that the IRS has revoked our exempt status due to our failure to file the required annual nonprofit organization report for three consecutive years. This is an automatic revocation and cannot be appealed. We can reapply for exemption. The cost for the filing is \$600. But there is no assurance we would be approved, especially given our club's low level of activity. Alternatively, we can just continue to operate without being an exempt organization, or as a corporation, as we did prior to 1998.

In any event, we will need to determine what penalties and back taxes we owe the IRS (not expected to be anything major) and settle up with the IRS.


GHA's by-laws state that upon dissolution of our exempt organization, our assets are to be given to a charitable organization. Our only asset is our bank account which has a balance of about \$5,000. This is approximately the amount we made on Conclave 99 which means essentially that every year since 1999 our income has been offset by our expenses.

The matter was tabled for further discussion at GHA's June 2022 meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:30pm.


